The American Association of Clinical Endocrinology (AACE) invites you to submit an education session proposal and have the unique opportunity to be part of the AACE 2024 Annual Meeting education program.

Please take a moment to read this entire guide prior to beginning the submission process to become familiar with the guidelines and rules that apply to submission.

The 2024 AACE Annual Meeting is structured to provide relevant clinical education for practicing endocrinologists, fellows, primary care physicians, physicians assistants, nurse practitioners, nurses, diabetes care and education specialists, clinical pharmacists, registered dietitians, and others in the endocrine care team. The program will focus on education that will allow you to achieve the best patient outcomes for the diagnosis, management, and treatment options for the care of your patients living with endocrine diseases.

The AACE Annual meeting will advance diversity, equity, and inclusion. We celebrate the diversity of our community members and the patients we treat. In our caring for others, we naturally strive for equity and inclusion. It only follows that the AACE Annual Meeting 2024 program must support these values, as well.

General Guidelines:

- Submission Deadline: <u>September 07, 2023, 11:59 PM ET.</u>

Session Format: Preferred session format (As the overall scientific program and experience is evaluated, the review committee may request changes to proposed items such as session format.)

 Meet the Professor: These sessions will include a didactic lecture with 1 speaker and 1 moderator, followed by a 5 – 10-minute Q&A. Polling questions are encouraged to engage the attendees on-site during the conference.

- Flipped Classroom: Speakers are asked to pre-record a 10-minute lecture to allow attendees to watch
 the video recordings in advance. Speakers will lead small group discussions on-site at the conference
 pertaining to the pre-recorded presentation. Attendees will be encouraged to access the pre-recorded
 sessions prior to attending the conference and come prepared for interactive discussions during these
 sessions to make the most out of the in-person experience.
- Case-Based Interactive Discussions: Speakers will develop and present 3-4 patient cases for attendee discussion. Pausing to use polling questions and posing inquiries to the audience throughout each case scenario will help to engage the audience. Interactive group discussions during these sessions are highly encouraged.
- AACE Talk Show: This session format consists of 1 moderator that serves as the talk show host, and a
 panel of speakers. The host will use an interview style format for content delivery. Interactive discussions
 on the session topic or a pro-con debate are encouraged. Presentation slides can be used but are not
 the main driver for the delivery of this session format.
- Leadership Session: This session type is geared towards non-clinical topics. These will take place in AACE's Collaboration Station and include interactive, collaborative discussions using a mix of group discussions and tabletop exercises.
