


# HOW TO CLAIM ENDURING CME CREDIT FOR CLP 2023

## READ THIS FIRST

- Recordings of CLP 2023 are now available on the meeting website: <https://clp2023.eventscribe.net/>
- The ENDURING CME claims process is now open and is scheduled to close on May 15, 2024. Once it closes, you cannot claim ENDURING CME credits thereafter.

## COMPLETE YOUR CME CLAIM

1. Login on the conference website <https://clp2023.eventscribe.net/> via the **Login** button top right using your Academy profile/account credentials then click the **Claim your CME** button under the Continuing Education section.

## HOW TO CLAIM CME CREDIT

This process allows you to claim **enduring** CME credit from now until midnight on May 15, 2024. Enduring activity refers to watching recordings of CLP 2023 educational sessions hosted on this website. You must complete your CME claim by the above deadline, as there will be no extensions and no opportunity to claim credits once the process has closed. The claims process cannot be re-opened once closed. To gain CME credits you must complete all tasks until they show green.

**Important:** you cannot claim enduring CME credit for sessions for which you previously claimed for live CME credit.
