### **1. When/where is NCAD East and NCAD West 2020?**

**NCAD East will be held July 31 - August 2, 2020 at the Hilton Inner Harbor, Baltimore, MD**

**NCAD West will be held August 17 - 19, 2020 at the Disneyland Hotel, Anaheim, CA**

### **2. What is the deadline for abstract submissions?**

**The deadline for NCAD East and West submissions is November 8, 2019 at midnight ET.**

### **3. How can I submit my abstract?**

**To submit a session abstract, please visit our submission website and create an account. Follow the instructions provided and be sure to fill out all required fields.**

### **4. May I include a table with my abstract?**

**No tables, figures, or images may be included in the abstract.**

### **5. How many presenters can be included in a session?**

**NCAD abstract sessions can have a maximum of 2 presenters.**

### **6. Can I revise my abstract after it has been submitted?**

**You can log back into your account and make changes to your abstract until it enters the review process. Once your submission has been marked for review, you will not be able to make any changes.**

### **7. Is there an abstract submission fee?**

**There is no fee to submit an abstract for a CME session at NCAD East/West.**

**8. What should I do if I would like to withdraw my abstract?**
