

# **Video Chat**

- Chat feature (private or to full group)
- Share screen option
- Raise hand button, mute button, show video, etc.
- Recommended for 20 or less people, but can have up to 30, upon request
- 1) The "Video Chat" button will appear in the event's listing pop up on the website see below.



2) Click the button and the "Video Chat" platform will launch automatically into the video chat room for the event – see below.

Note: Attendees can join in a video chat without a camera. They will be able to see and hear the group, they just won't be visible.





## 3) Video Chat Controls

• Once you have launched the chat, take a moment to familiarize yourself with the tools and features available:



#### a) Bottom Left Corner:

- -Computer Icon: This will allow you to share your screen with other participants
- -Hand Icon: Allows you to digitally "raise your hand" and alert the chat that you have a question
- -Speech Bubble: You can send messages within the video chat to other participants

### b) Bottom Center:

- -Microphone Icon: You can mute/unmute the microphone on your device
- -Red Phone Icon: Clicking this will "hang up" the chat, and users will see that you have left the room
- -Camera Icon: This will allow you to turn the camera on your device on/off

#### c) Bottom Right:

- -Four Squares Icon: You can click this to toggle the orientation of how the users appear in your window
- -Three Vertical Dots Icon: This will open up to a menu with additional options such as blurring your background, adjusting the resolution, and more.  $_{\it A}$
