


## ACVIM Forum On Demand – CE Quiz User Guide

### Continuing Education (CE) Credits

The 2020 ACVIM Forum On Demand Interactive Platform offers continuing education to meet the unique needs of each user. To earn your CE credits, complete the quizzes for each recorded session and ePoster you attend and is eligible for CE credit. All recorded sessions and ePosters that have been **RACE-approved** will have the red icon indicator. 

To receive CE credit, recorded session and ePoster quizzes must be taken and passed with a score of 70% or higher. A maximum of 3 attempts will be allowed. Earned credits are tracked as you successfully complete each quiz. As a registered attendee, you are able to access sessions and earn CE credits through December 31, 2020. CE Certificates will be available through December 31, 2020 and will reflect all CE credits earned to that point in time.

Note: There are two CE Quiz/Eval platforms, one for the recorded sessions and one for the ePosters. Therefore, once your learning is complete, you will have two CE Certificates issued – one with all recorded sessions and one for all ePosters.

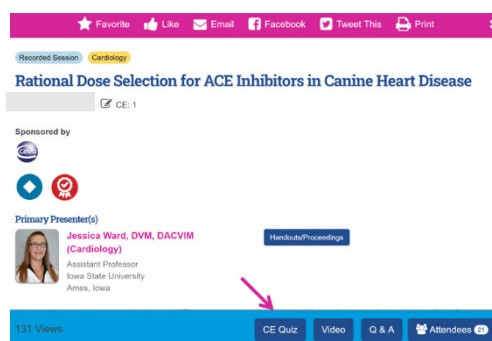
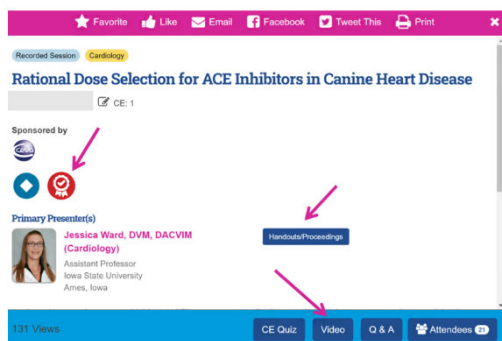
### Access CE Quizzes for Recorded Sessions and ePosters

3. **Listen** to the recordings for the recorded sessions and ePosters and view handouts/proceedings associated with each recorded session

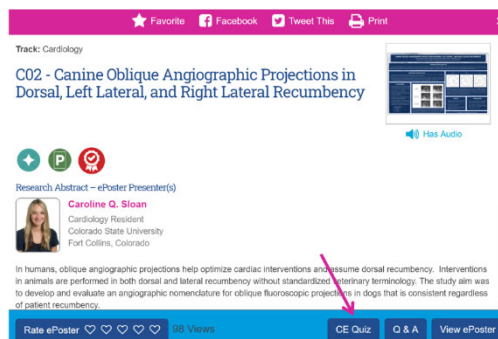
### Session Pop Up View (RECOMMENDED)

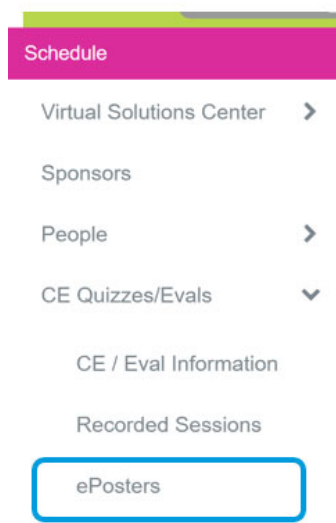
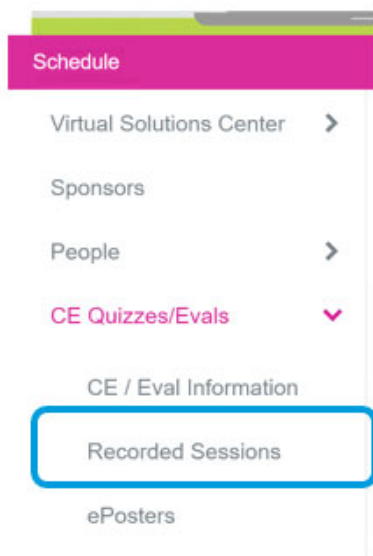


### ePoster View

6. Scroll down to the **TASKS** section of the page

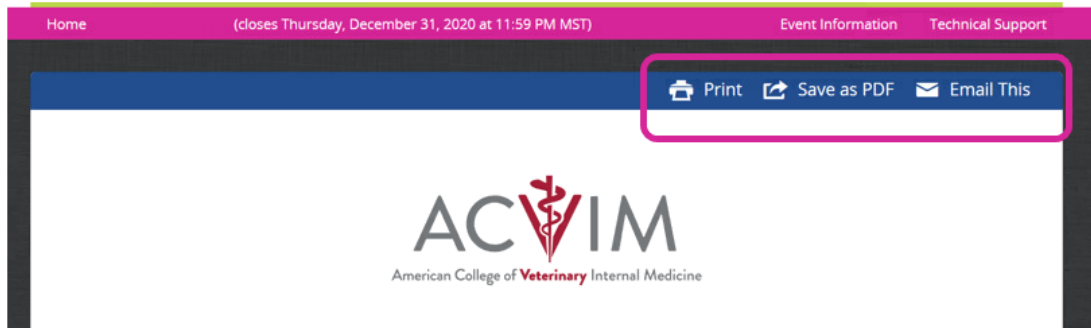

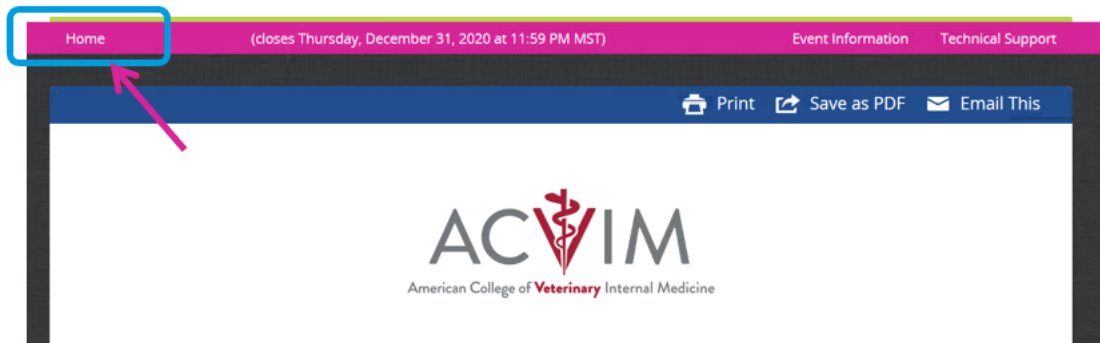
