Teaching/Learning Strategies

Teaching strategies are methods by which presenters provide content to participants. Teaching strategies for conference sessions should reflect adult learning principles. Strategies that reflect these principles include lecture/group discussion, small-group sessions, skill practice sessions, question-and-answer sessions, audiovisual aids, role-playing, games, clinical application, simulations, evaluations, and handouts. Consider the teaching strategies you plan to utilize to make sure that each is congruent with the objectives and content covered.
