



ACR23 Global Rheumatology Summit

The ACR Global Summit will provide a platform to highlight the global burden of rheumatologic diseases, the challenges and success of different health systems and international rheumatology professionals. It will continue to create a space to bring rheumatologists and health professionals together from different parts of the world to talk about topics that are of mutual relevance and concern.

The 2023 program will continue to showcase innovative rheumatology education, training, research, and partnerships around the world. The Summit will address the need to develop clinical and research capacity in low-resource settings, and to better understand how diverse geographies, ethnic, genetic and environmental variability, or health system disparities uniquely influence epidemiology and outcomes of rheumatologic and musculoskeletal diseases.

It will feature a Global Meet the Experts session on RA and a spotlight on global researchers. The summit will highlight sustainable health programs, examples of international to local education and explore global drug development-how rheumatology drugs are being developed, tested, and marketed around the world and the success and failures in terms of delivery of important medications to under resourced areas. The target audience is rheumatologists, general practitioners, health professionals who care for patients with rheumatic disease, and those engaged in research, education, and advocacy.

Be part of the Global Rheumatology Summit! The summit will include two sessions built by learners' participation. Learners are invited to submit a case on Rheumatoid Arthritis and/or an example of Sustainable Rheumatology Health programs around the world.

Submission Guidelines

Global Meet the Experts:

Global Meet the Experts is a virtual educational series offered quarterly to a global audience of rheumatologists and rheumatology health professionals.

A Global Meet the Experts session will take place within the Global Rheumatology Summit and will focus on **Rheumatoid Arthritis**

Cases will be submitted in advance from around the world, and leading rheumatology experts will discuss and debate key questions and learning points arising from these cases.

Case Submission: Submit your diagnostically challenging case of RA or RA case that has a difficult/refractory management course.

The review committee will select up to four cases based on teaching value for inclusion. If your case is accepted, you will be supported to pre-record a 5-minute presentation with the ACR team.

- You may submit up to two cases.
- Each case must be submitted in PowerPoint format.

- Cases must not be more than six slides and must follow this format:
 - Slide 1: Title slide – Please include the case title and your information. The case title should be intriguing and make the reader curious. The title should not disclose the diagnosis. Please include your name, title, company/institution, city, country
 - Slide 2: Introduction to the case
 - Slide 3-4: Provide a clinical overview of the case
 - Slide 5: State diagnostic or therapeutic dilemma
 - Slide 6: Include questions for the experts

Capacity Building in Global Rheumatology:

Have you developed or implemented a capacity building rheumatology program. How have different programs been designed and used to improve patient care, education, or research in the field of rheumatology? If so, we invite you to the global stage to share your experience.

Capacity Building programs can include but are not limited to programs to increase access to diagnosis, clinical algorithms or protocols, research initiatives, education programs and/or platforms, and registries.

Share your innovation: In 500 words, describe the collaboration you have developed or implemented to solve a challenge in the field of rheumatology.

The review committee will select up to four programs to showcase in the Global Rheumatology Summit. If your submission is accepted, you will be invited to pre-record a 10-minute presentation with the ACR's Production team between September 15 - 30, 2023, for inclusion in the Global Rheumatology Summit and be invited to participate in live Q&A on Friday, November 10, 2023. You will also receive complimentary registration to ACR Convergence 2023.
